Types of Submissions

The Conference Scientific Committee calls interested parties to submit:

A. PAPERS

Research papers (complete original research works and studies)

Educational interventions (papers presenting scientifically grounded educational interventions integrating ICTs, tested in real educational settings and evaluated as per their pedagogical value)

Posters: Phd candidates can present their research proposals. Researchers, teachers and educators can discuss ideas not yet mature with members of the research/scientific community.

B. TRAINING EVENTS

Round table Panels: The organisation of open discussions around a specialised issue is proposed, which is of wide interest the research and teaching ICT communities, is current, innovating or invokes scientific debate. Predicted maximum duration of each panel: 90 minutes. To enable a greater degree of conference attendee participation, each panel is proposed to include a maximum of five (5) participants/rapporteurs. The panel proposal will include the theme and its grounding/documentation, the participants/rapporteurs and a brief presentation of their interventions.

Workshops / Tutorials: Hands-on training in digital environments and/or products (preferably open source) of interest to teachers and researchers. The workshop/tutorial proposal will include the scope of the workshop, the digital environment and/or product and its added educational value, the audience addressed and the organisation proposed.

All papers should be written in Greek or English. All papers will be reviewed using a double-blind review system and accepted papers will be published the conference proceedings.

Authors should use the *paper template* of the conference. Paper submission will be done through the EasyChair system.

Important Dates

- December 19th 2016: Submission of full text for all categories of submissions
- February 13th 2017: Notification of authors
- March 6th 2017: Submission of final texts for conference proceedings

Registration – Attendance certificates

Registration and participation at the conference has no financial cost for participants.

All authors of selected papers for publication in the conference proceedings will receive a certificate of presentation of paper, specifying the type of submission of the paper. All participants (non-authors) will receive a conference participation certificate.
