

HOUSING

- **Limited accommodation available for incoming students at the Student Residence Hall** located on ASPETE's Campus. As accommodation at the specific Student Residence Hall is issued on a first come, first served basis, you are advised to submit your application as soon as possible. If it is not possible to find you accommodation there, or you prefer to find your own place to live, we will be happy to give you some tips.
- Students who want to choose their own flat (shared or not) should arrive in Athens at least a week before the beginning of the term. Since the easiest access to ASPETE is by metro/train, a good option would be a flat near a metro/train station. There is usually a wide offer of flats for rent in the city and/or in areas near ASPETE (eg. N. Heraklion, N. Ionia, Maroussi). Until permanent accommodation is found, students may stay in Youth Hostels located in the centre of Athens, at relatively low prices.
